ABOUT THE GMEP

The Goldfields Migrant Employment Project (GMEP) aims to alleviate the labor and skills shortage in the Goldfields region by engaging with migrant communities based in metropolitan areas of WA and assisting employment seekers with access to Goldfields-based job opportunities and ancillary settlement support services.

The project aims to promote to metropolitan migrant communities job opportunities and regional living in the Goldfields and assist with attracting and retaining employees. This will include facilitated engagement between potential employees, employers, and the local Goldfields community, to build strong relations to support those moving to the region.

PROJECT NETWORK

- ✓ Network of over 5000 migrants and refugees in Perth
- ✓ Over 50 participants connected to employment between August 2019 and November 2020.
- ✓ Over 20 Pending placements and most of them with valuable qualifications.
- ✓ The majority of Jobseekers are willing to relocate and live in the Goldfields for community appeal.
